## CDBG PROGRAM PURPOSE

THE DEVELOPMENT OF VIABLE URBAN  
COMMUNITIES BY PROVIDING:

- DECENT HOUSING
- SUITABLE LIVING ENVIRONMENTS
- ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY



## NATIONAL OBJECTIVES

EACH PROJECT FUNDED WITH CDBG MONIES  
MUST MEET ONE OF THE FOLLOWING  
OBJECTIVES:

- ✓ BENEFIT TO LOW AND MODERATE INCOME  
FAMILIES
- ✓ HELP ELIMINATE/PREVENT BLIGHT
- ✓ MEET AN URGENT NEED



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY??

- NON-PROFIT COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS  
(85%)
- CITY/COUNTY GOVERNMENTS (10%)
- FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION/BUSINESS (5%)



## WHO RECEIVES CDBG FUNDS?

- ✓ CITIES WITH POPULATIONS GREATER THAN 50,000
- ✓ URBAN COUNTIES WITH POPULATIONS GREATER  
THAN 200,000



## CDBG PROGRAM ALLOCATIONS

ENTITLEMENT COMMUNITIES IN CONTRA COSTA COUNTY:

- ANTIOCH - \$753,342
- CONCORD - \$1,065,329
- PITTSBURG - \$668,888
- RICHMOND - \$1,405,549
- WALNUT CREEK - \$333,203
- CONTRA COSTA COUNTY - \$3,541,040



## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FUNDING CATEGORY GUIDELINES

- ❖ 45 PERCENT - HOUSING
- ❖ 14 PERCENT - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
- ❖ 15 PERCENT - PUBLIC SERVICE
- ❖ 4 PERCENT - INFRASTRUCTURE/PUBLIC FACILITIES
- ❖ 2 PERCENT - CONTINGENCY
- ❖ 20 PERCENT - ADMINISTRATION



## HOUSING OBJECTIVES

- INCREASE HOMEOWNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES
- EXPAND RENTAL HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES BY INCREASING THE SUPPLY
- MAINTAIN AND PRESERVE EXISTING HOUSING STOCK
- ASSIST THE HOMELESS BY PROVIDING EMERGENCY AND TRANSITIONAL HOUSING



## ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES

- REDUCE THE NUMBER OF PERSONS LIVING BELOW THE POVERTY LEVEL
- EXPAND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR LOWER INCOME PERSONS
- INCREASE THE VIABILITY OF NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL AREAS



## PUBLIC SERVICE OBJECTIVES

- ENSURE THAT OPPORTUNITIES AND SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE AND INDEPENDENCE FOR LOWER-INCOME FAMILIES
- ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE OF SENIORS AND ENABLE THEM TO MAINTAIN INDEPENDENCE
- INCREASE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN/YOUTH TO BE HEALTHY, SUCCEED IN SCHOOL AND PREPARE FOR PRODUCTIVE ADULTHOOD



## INFRASTRUCTURE/PUBLIC FACILITIES OBJECTIVES

- MAINTAIN QUALITY PUBLIC FACILITIES AND ADEQUATE INFRASTRUCTURE, AND ENSURE ACCESS FOR THE MOBILITY IMPAIRED BY ADDRESSING PHYSICAL ACCESS BARRIERS TO PUBLIC FACILITIES



## APPLICATION FUNDING CRITERIA

- TWO YEAR FUNDING CYCLE
- INTENDED PURPOSE
- PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT OUTCOMES
- CONSISTENCY WITH ESTABLISHED PRIORITIES
- ELIGIBILITY
- TARGET POPULATIONS AND DEMONSTRATED NEED
- FINANCIAL ANALYSIS
- EXPERIENCE AND CAPACITY



## SUBRECIPIENT OBLIGATIONS

- ENTER INTO CDBG AGREEMENT (INSURANCE, AUDIT, ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES, ETC.)
- MAINTAIN CLIENT/CUSTOMER RECORDS
- SUBMIT QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REPORTS
- SUBMIT DEMANDS FOR PAYMENT ON A REGULAR BASIS
- BE PREPARED TO GET MONITORED
