North Korea took the step of submitting for outside review a long awaited declaration of its nuclear program. Rep. Ellen Tauscher, Chairman of the Strategic Forces Subcommittee of the House Armed Services Committee, released the following.

"It is reassuring to know that North Korea has taken this critical step to share information regarding its nuclear program with rest of the world. This signals a good faith step toward peace and cooperation and paves the way for taking North Korea off the state sponsor of terror list, giving some of the world's most isolated and impoverished people the humanitarian aid they desperately need.

"While the data North Korea has provided on its plutonium production history is welcome, I still have remaining concerns about its uranium production and the extent of its proliferation activities. North Korea must be irrevocably committed to ceasing its nuclear weapons activities and removing all fuel from its Yongbyon plutonium facility if it is to become a responsible member of the international community."
