

Fiscal Year 2010 Surface Transportation Project Requests

On behalf of the 10th Congressional District, I have made the following requests for funding in the surface transportation authorization bill:

- Construct improvements on SR 4 East from Somersville Road to SR160 in east Contra Costa County. Request amount: \$40 million
- Upgrade and reconstruct the I–80/I–680/SR 12 Interchange, Solano County. Request amount: \$45 million.
- Conduct environmental review, design, acquire right-of-way and construct a highway widening project, including HOV lanes, auxiliary lanes and operational improvements in both directions on I-580 between Greenville Road and Foothill Blvd. Request amount: \$20 million
- Construct Fairfield Transportation Center (FTC) Expansion Project. Request amount: \$16.455 million
- Replace rail cars – San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit. Request amount: \$300 million
- Install a real time bus stop information system along with a modernized radio communications emergency system at Central Contra Costa Transit Authority. Request amount: \$3.6 million
- Acquire right-of-way, design, engineer and construct the Vasco Road Safety Improvement Project in Contra Costa County, CA. Request amount: \$20 million
- Complete Engineering Design and Construct the Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA) Atlantis Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Facility Project. Request amount: \$5 million.
- Construct the Vanden Road element of the Jepson Parkway project, including right-of-way acquisition. Request amount: \$10 million
- Design and construct access improvements, including acquiring right-of-ways, to Travis Air Force Base. Request amount: \$5 million
- Conduct preliminary engineering/environmental review, and acquire right-of-way to construct improvements to the I-580/Vasco Road Interchange, including overpass bridge widening, on/off ramp and lane re-configurations and intersection signalization. Request amount: \$5 million
- Construct highway and bike/ped improvements for the SR4 East Corridor - SR4 Bypass. Request amount: \$60 million.
- Construct additional travel lanes on State Route 84 in Livermore, California between Ruby Hill Drive and Jack London Boulevard. Request amount: \$20 million
- Plan, purchase right of way, engineer, design, and construct a network of Park-and-Ride lots in eastern Contra Costa County. Request amount: \$15.06 million
- Rehabilitate Air Base Parkway from Interstate 80 to Travis Air Force Base Main Gate. Request amount: \$5.75 million
- Rehabilitate and realign Vasco Road in Alameda County. Request amount: \$20 million
- Conduct environmental review, design, acquire right-of-way, and construct the I-680 Southbound High Occupancy Vehicle Gap Closure between North Main Street and Livorna Road. Request amount: \$10 million
- Design, acquire right-of-way, and construct I-680 Transit Corridor Improvements including aux lane between Sycamore VLY Rd and Crow CYN Rd in both directions, and complete pre-construction activities for the carpool ramps at Norris CYN Rd. Request amount: \$28 million
- Design and construct the Installation of New Utility Infrastructure to Provide Alternative Power for Ocean-going Vessels at Berth (“Cold-Ironing”) at the Port of Oakland. Request amount: \$5 million
- Design and engineer the construction of the Oakland Army Base Intermodal Rail Development (Outer Harbor Intermodal Terminal) at the Port of Oakland. Request amount: \$5 million

- Conduct environmental review, design, right-of-way acquisition, and construct an extension of BART rail service to Livermore, California. Request amount: N/A
- Implement the Sustainable Transportation Center as a University Transportation Center at the University of California, Davis. Request amount: \$500,000
- Implement the Center for Transit-Oriented Development. Request amount: \$12 million
