Ellen Tauscher, Chairman of the Strategic Forces Subcommittee of the House Armed Services Committee, will join Democratic Senators as well as Iraq and Afghanistan veterans Tuesday to discuss the ongoing debate on Iraq. Tauscherâ€™s legislation has passed the House of Representatives and a similar version is currently stalled in the Senate.
